1. Staffing

2. Community Forestry Management Program

- Was going to have Bill Brash here today, but postponed until a majority of board members will be here in person
- Still proposing hiring another staff member as a forester and reviewer.

3. State Soil Conservation Committee (SSCC) 2/11/24 Meeting

- The SSCC had requested that each district complete a selfevaluation form supplied by them. The results were tabulated and presented at this meeting.
- The district audit were part of this. The rule state that audits should be initiated no later than September 1st.
- A copy of the completed audit should be sent to the SSCC within 180 days of the end of the fiscal year. This is not always possible because of the government figures needed to complete the audits are not always provided to the auditors by this time.
- The NJACD adopted a rough draft of their budget. Ines

 Association is currently working on the NACD Fly-In and the NJ
