X. <u>District Manager's Report</u>

1. Audit

- Brian Logan, the auditor from Suplee, Clooney & Company, was here to further explain the comments and recommendations made in the FY2023 completed audit
- Many questions were asked by the board members regarding the comments and were answered by Mr. Logan
- Wayne VanHise made a motion to accept the Fiscal Year 2023 audit as presented and to send a copy along with the District's comments to their recommendations to the State Soil Conservation Committee. Donald Patterson seconded the motion and the motion was passed by the following roll call vote: Mr. VanHise yes, Mr. Patterson yes, and Mr. Buscaglia yes (Mr. Dreyer left before this vote was taken)

2. Administrative Committee

- The administrative committee met before this meeting to discuss salaries and other budgetary items for the upcoming Fiscal Year 2025 budget
- The full FY2025 budget will be presented at the June meeting for approval

3. Changing of Banks

- Charlie, Tim and Christina met to discuss the issues with Provident Bank in regards to changing the authorized signers on the accounts
- After much discussion, it was determined it was in the best interest of the District to close the accounts at Provident Bank and move the three accounts (Chapter 251, District and Payroll) to Freehold Bank
- The transition went very smoothly and all accounts are now moved and active

4. Database Install

- The final tests have been done, and the updated database is ready to be installed on our servers for District use
- Coordination of Control Point Associates, us and Freehold Township IT need to be made for the in-house conversion to be completed (should be done by mid-June)

5. Selling Database

- A few other districts have voiced an interest in purchasing the update version of our database
- When the District first moved to the access based program five other districts purchased the database for their use
- Once we have it up and running, we will be able to determine a far selling price of the program only. Any district that wishes to purchase the program will be responsible for their own IT upkeep

6. Northeast Regional Meeting

- The Northeast Regional Conference will be held in Boston, MA from August 10-13, 2024
- On the website, the current "early bird" registration deadline is June 30th. Tim spoke to them stating that this date is an issue with fiscal year expense cutoffs. Waiting to see if the date will be pushed back a few days
